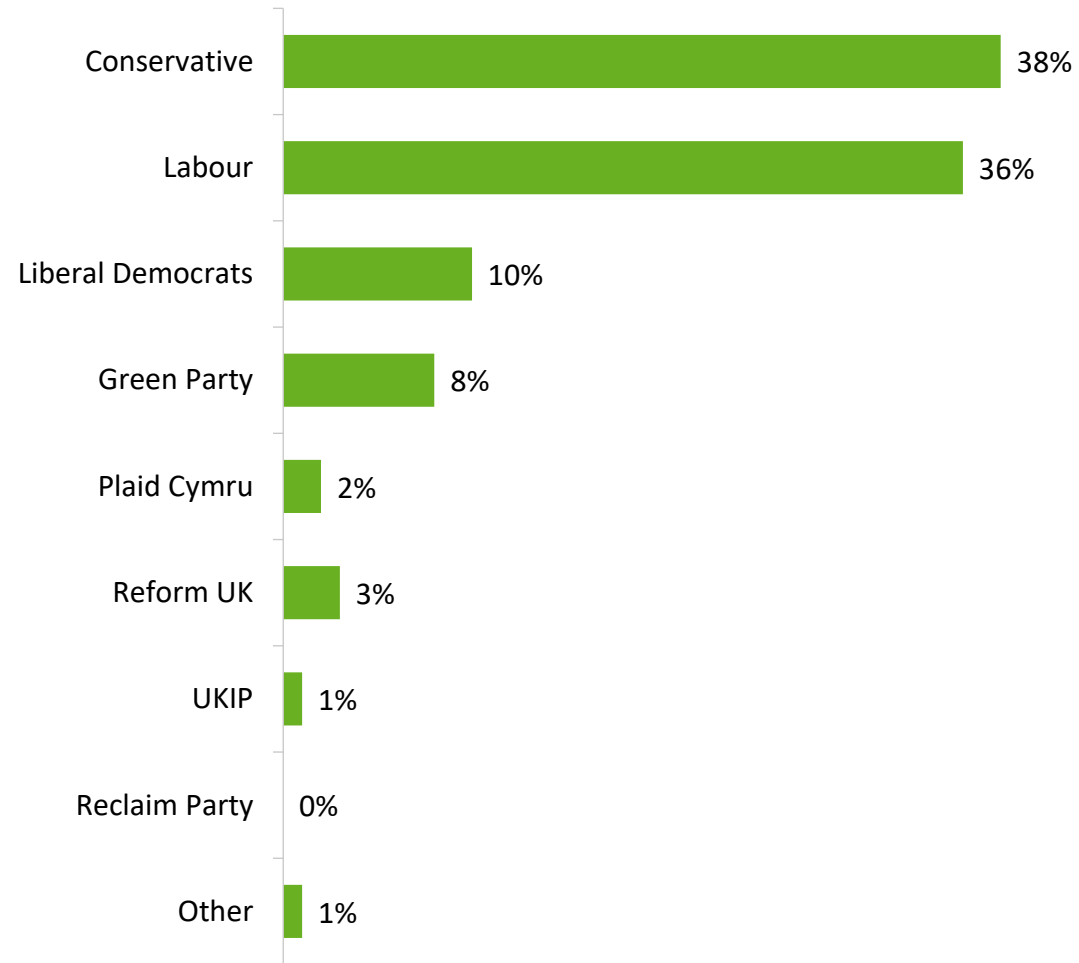

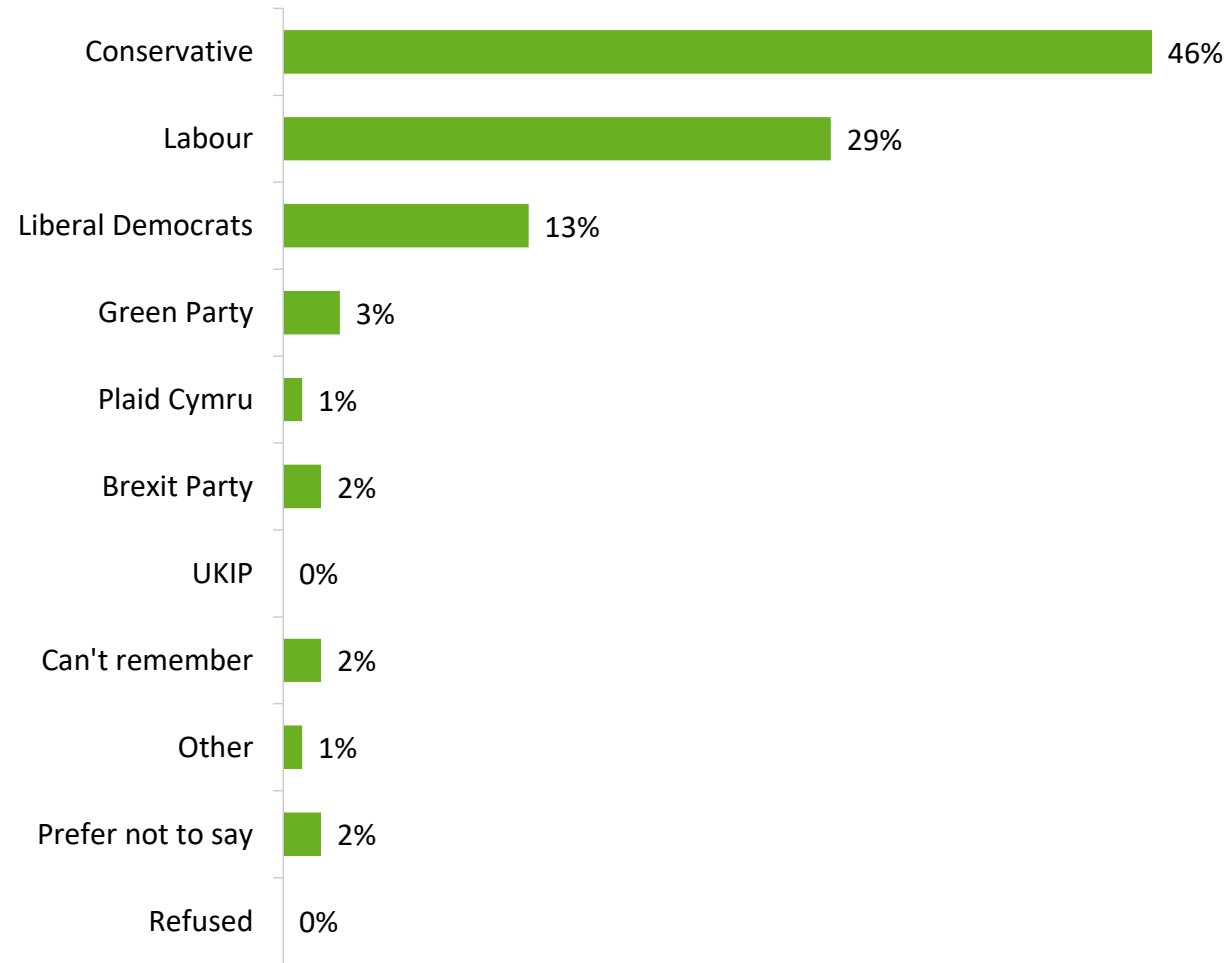

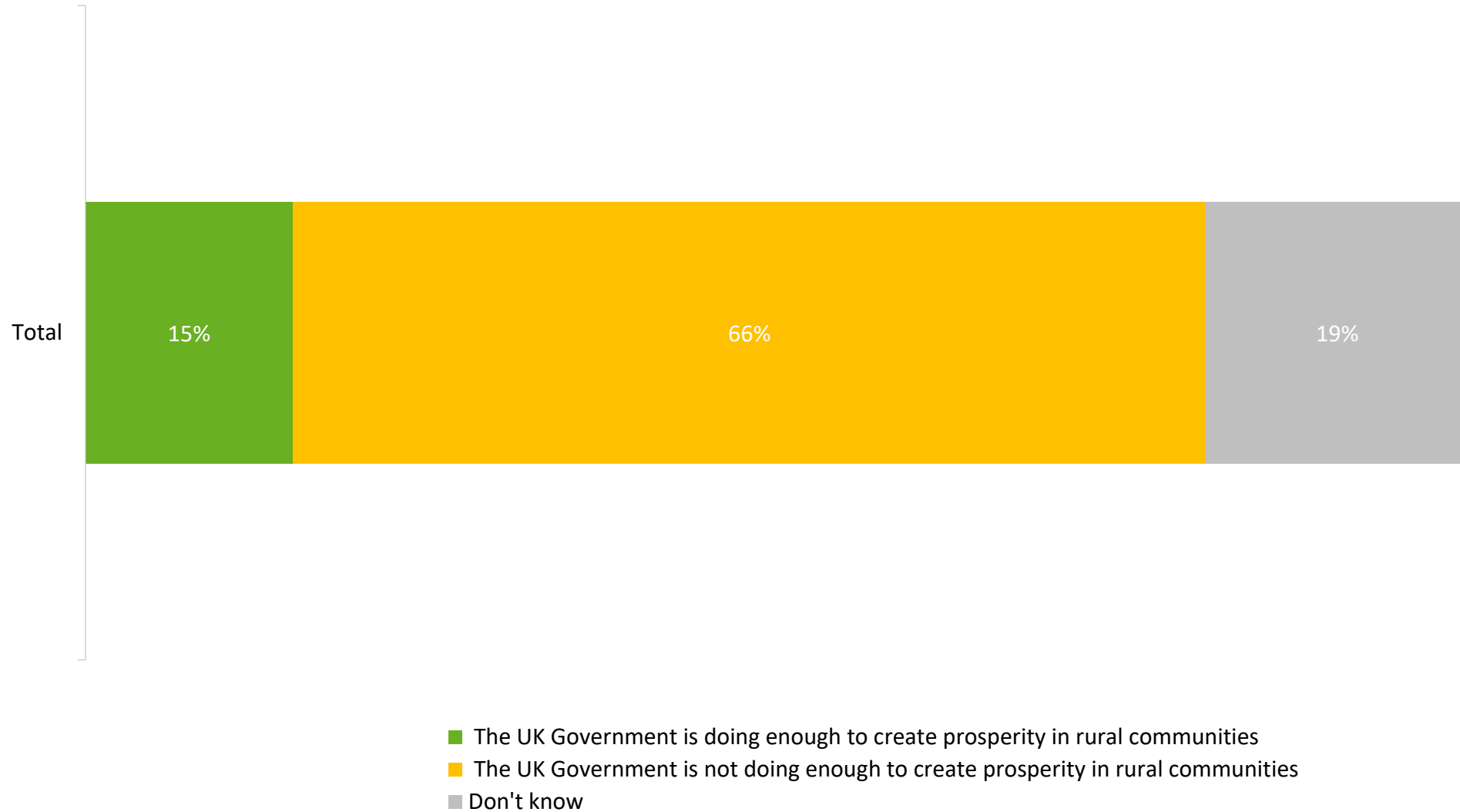

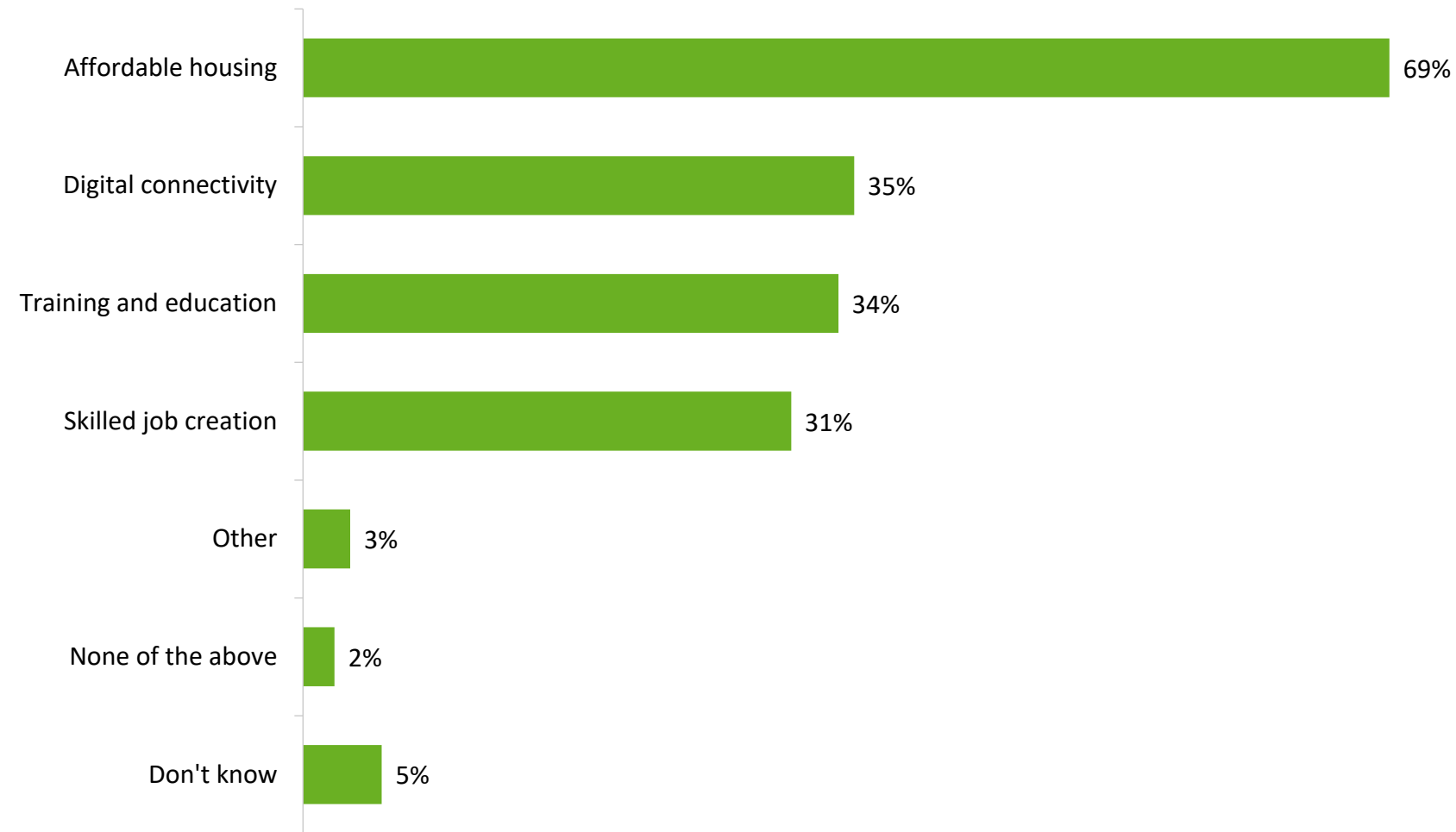

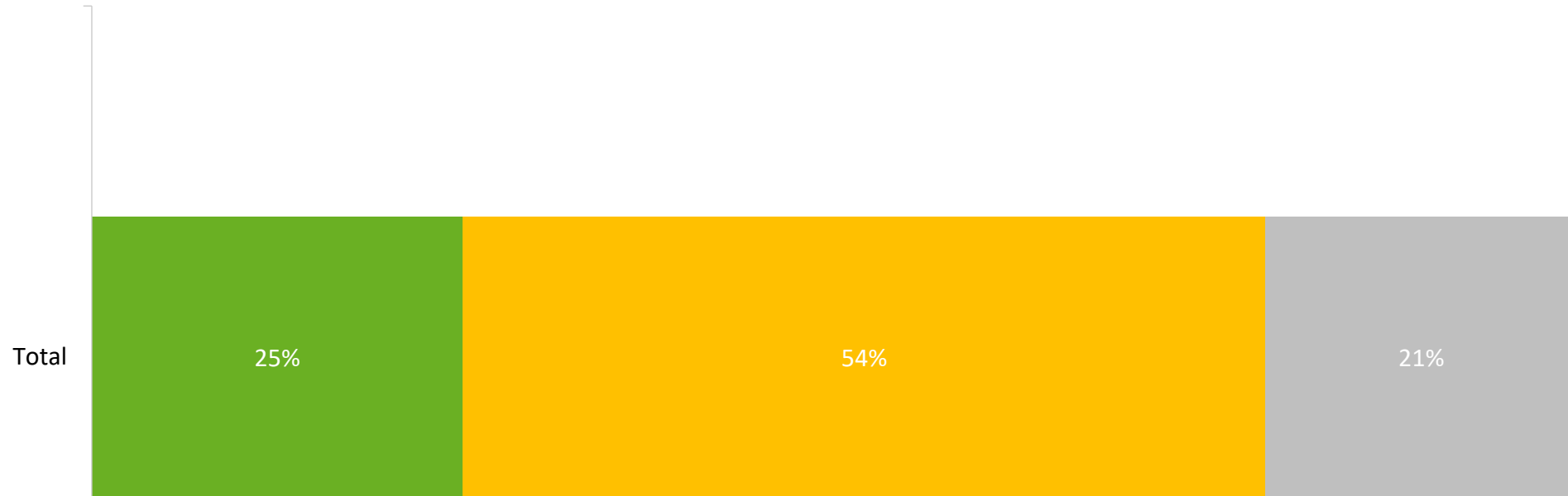
Q5. Which of the following statements is closest to your view?



Q6. Which of the following policies, if any, should the government prioritise for the rural economy? Please select up to two.

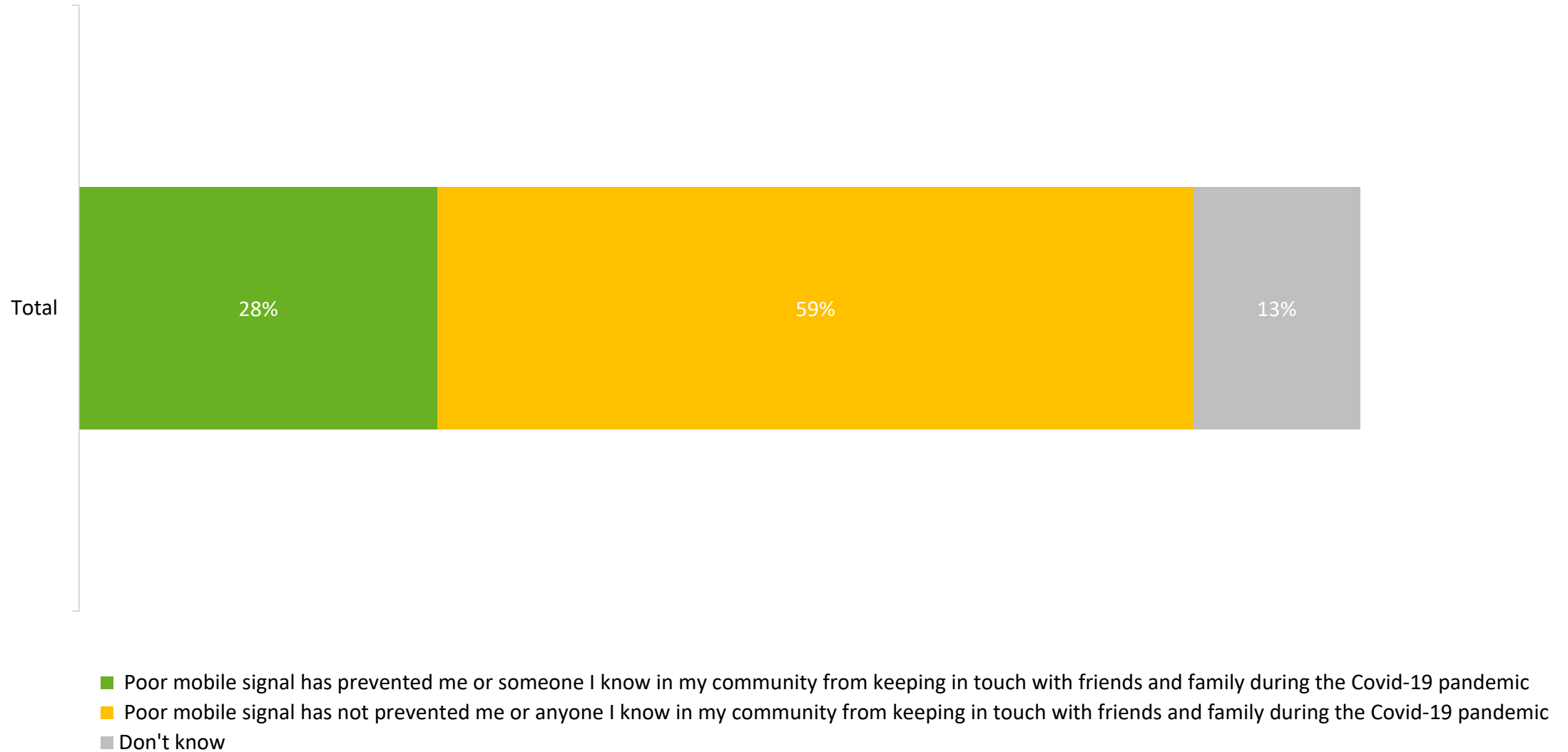


Q7. Which of the following statements is closest to your experience?

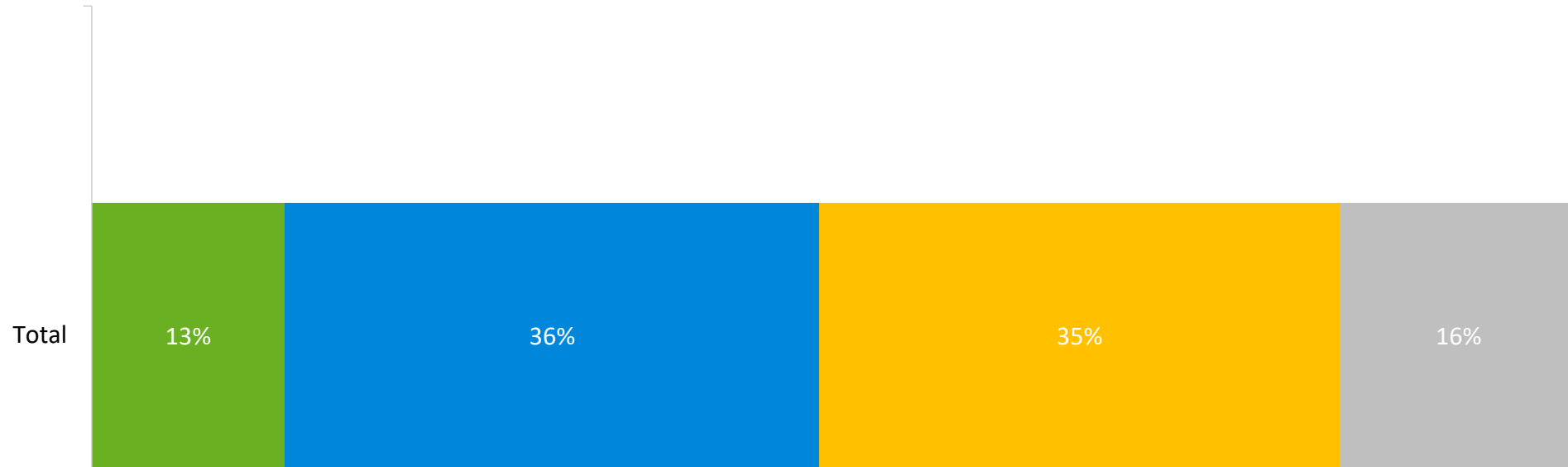


- A slow internet connection has prevented me or someone I know in my community from working from home during the Covid-19 pandemic

Q8. Which of the following statements is closest to your experience?

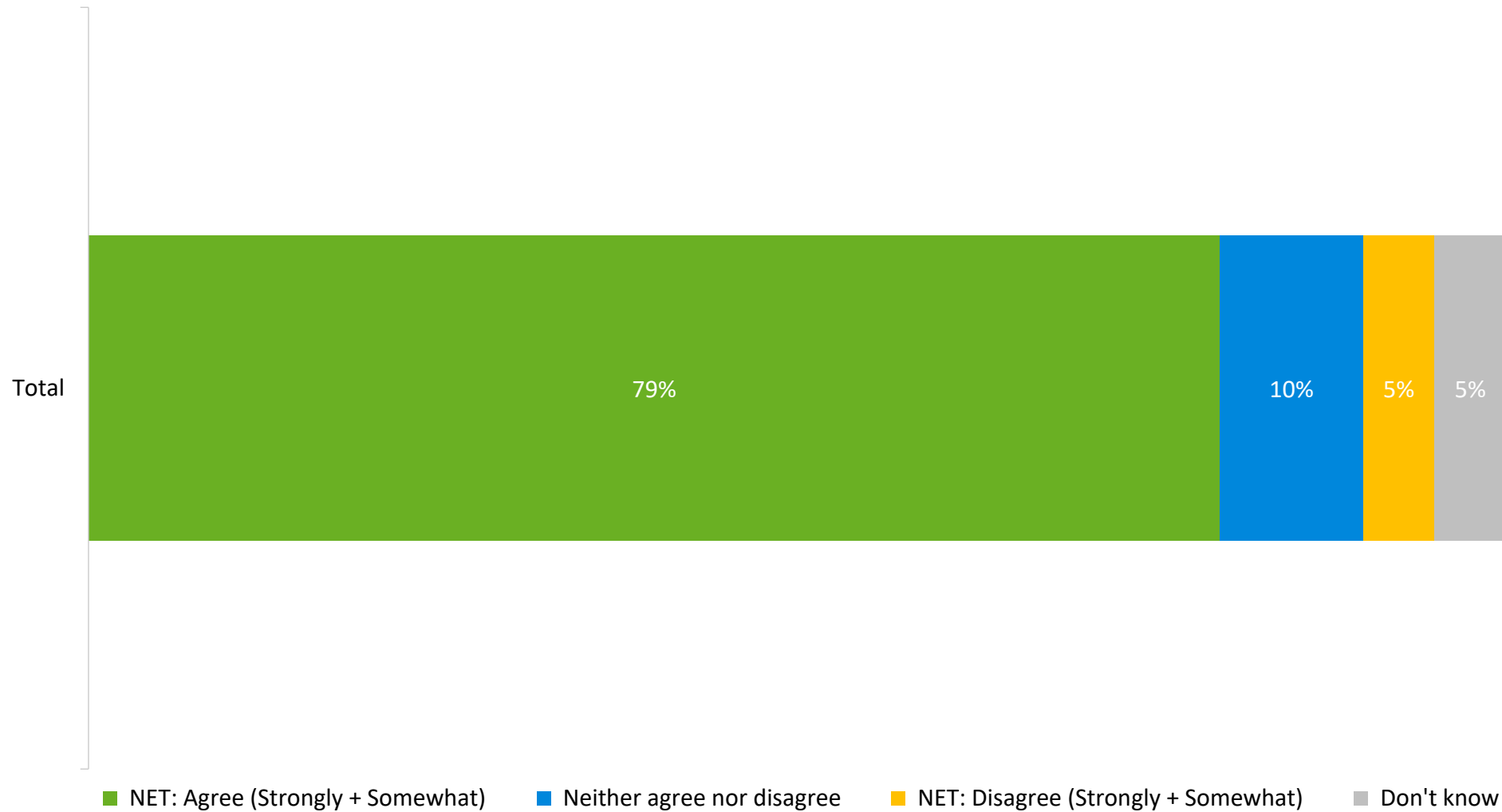

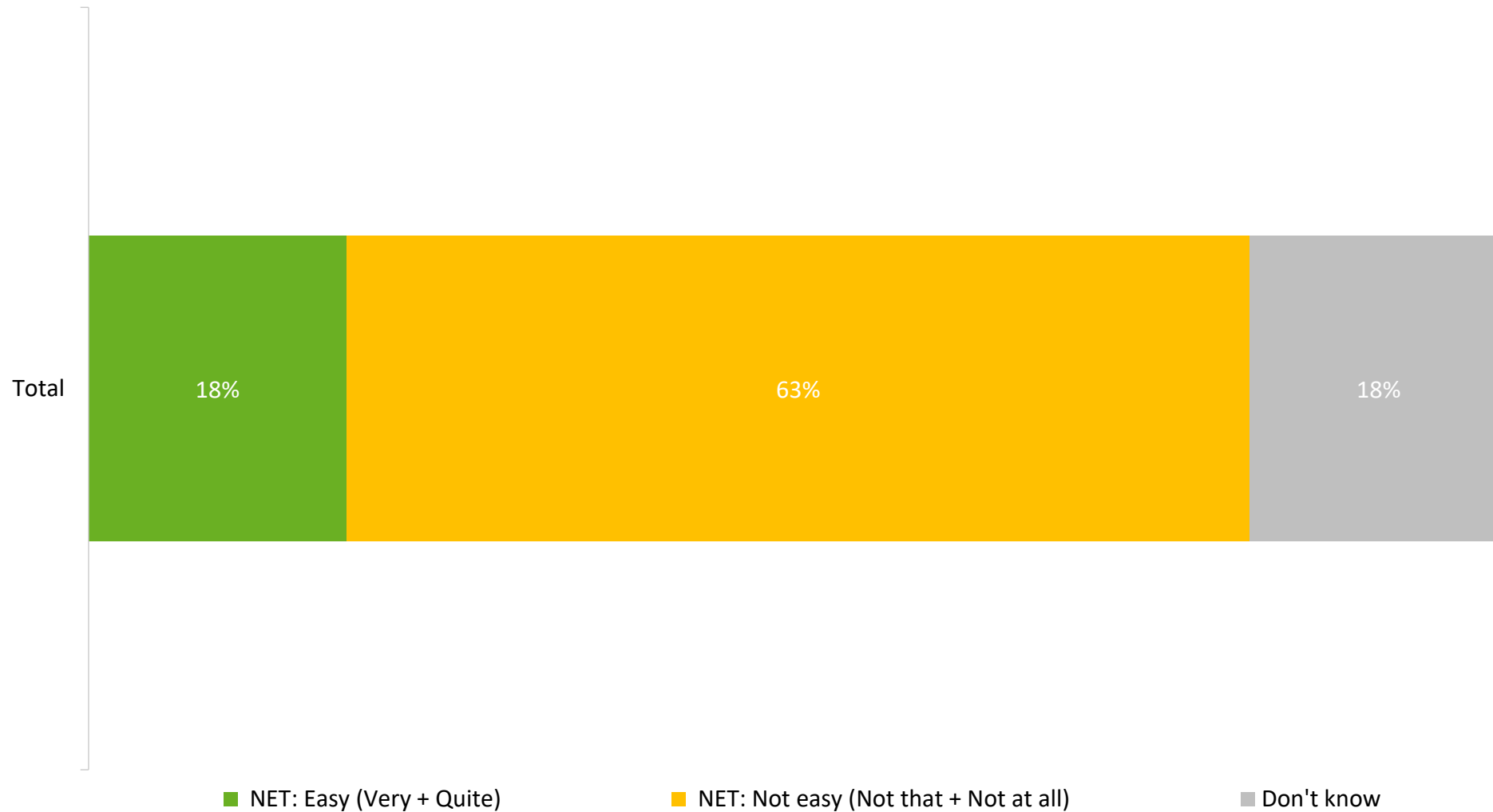


- The likelihood of young people obtaining employment in my local area has increased compared to five years ago
